The simplest way to make a planned gift is through a **Charitable Bequest** to Green Works in your will or living trust. You can structure the bequest to leave a financial gift of any amount, leave a specific item of value, make a gift contingent on certain events, or leave a percentage of your estate to Green Works. There are tax benefits as well if your estate is subject to estate taxes; your gift is entitled to an estate tax charitable deduction for the full value of the gift. To make a charitable bequest, all that is needed are a few sentences in a current will or revocable living trust. Contact your attorney, estate planner or the Green Works staff to learn specifics.

Beneficiary designations within life insurance policies or retirement plans are another easy way to ensure your personal commitment to Green Works is honored. You only need to designate a dollar amount or percentage of the policy or plan and include the EIN# for Green Works on the beneficiary designation form to be filed with your insurance company or retirement plan provider.
